The KeyPM assessment certifies the fundamental knowledge of Project Management on the principles defined by the Project Management Institute (PMI).

The assessment consists of the administration of 50 multiple-choice questions that verify the basic knowledge of Project Management.

Administration Time, 60 minutes.

- X. Project Stakeholder Management (6%).

The assessment is passed if the correct answers exceed 70% (35 out of 50)
